Wabash College Wireless AccessPoint Policy Version 1.0, January 13, 2011

Background

The Wabash Colleged at a network is an essential campus resource that supports all areas of the campus community, including teaching and learning, research administrative offices, and residential life. The Information Technology Service (ITS ervices) lepartment has designed and maintains the Wabashnetwork to ensure robust, reliable, and high quality service for all network users.

In order to provide the highest level of service to all students, faculty, and staff, Wabash T Service shas established the following policy regarding wireless acces points.

Policy

- 1. All wirelessaccespoints on the WabashCollegecampuswill be installed and maintained by IT Services.
- 2. Students, employees and other campususers may not connect their own wireless accesso ints to the Wabashnetwork, or establishindependentwireless networks on the Wabash College campus.
- 3. WirelessNetworkInterfaceCards(NICs)may not be configured to serve as an accessoint.
- 4. Studentsandemployeeswho find areason campuswith poor connectivity to the Wabashwirelessnetwork should report the issue to the ITServicesHelpDesk(helpdesk@wabash.edu65.361.6400).

Rationale

Wirelessnetworkingdeviceshavea limited set of radio frequencies in which to operate. Accessoints operating independently of the Wabashwirelessnetwork create interference with campusaccessoints, and can significantly degrade (or even prevent) network accessor other users.

Sanctions

Violations of the above policies may result in termination of network privileges and will be reported to the Dean of Students Office, the Dean of the College or the Director of Human Resources appropriate.
